Deputy Supervisor Lyons called the meeting to order at 7:02pm asking all to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC: Bridget Burke asked Highway Superintendent about fixing the end of Ackerson Road so people can use the picnic area.

APPROVE MINUTES:

- a. Motion by Council Member Weale seconded by Council Member Becker, to approve the June 5, 2025 minutes as written.

DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS:

a. Assessor – Final Assessment Role was filed, copy in the Town Clerk’s Office and Notice posted in the Addison Post.

b. Hwy Superintendent – Graded Miller and Gaffney Roads, chased parts for the Ford Tractor, 3 point hitch arm broke – had to weld. Sprayed weeds around shop and mowed, fixed Greengrass Road driveway from a big wash out, put new alternator on the Roller, picked up 3 dead deer on Hardscrabble Road Met with Bendan Geiss, Western Star, Cab and Chassis will be delivered around July 27, 2025. Fuel log submitted, fuel usage was 189.0 gallons.

c. Town Clerk, Town Justice, DCO and Bookkeepers reports were read as submitted. Town Clerk noted that there are currently 20 expired dog licenses. Received report from the Fire Department and Ambulance Corps. Made 6 runs for 17.6 hours and used 11 gallons of fuel. Bookkeeper received checks from Town Clerk - \$636.60, and Justice - \$800.00.

OLD BUSINESS:

- a. Sell Rock Crusher – Highway Superintendent asked what the minimum bid was - \$5,000.
- b. Road Use Agreement for Solar Project - Highway Superintendent stated he has tried to contact S.W.E.B. but no response. POC is Jocelyn at (508) 492-9895.
- c. New Law requiring .gov domain. Town Clerk is working with Mike Fay.
- d. Rabies Clinic donations – tabled till next month.

NEW BUSINESS:

- a. Proposal to dissolve the village – Council Member Lyons attended the meeting and reported that CGI presented a package showing what the village will lose/gain. Proposition will need to be approved and added to the Ballot for Village residents to vote on. If approved, the village will be dissolved December 31, of the year approved.
- b. Bookkeeper inquired about how much the Highway Superintendent intended to spend the remainder of the year because the DB account balance was negative. Motion by Supervisor Thompson, seconded by Council Member Weale, to Transfer \$250,000.00 from the DB CSR to DB Money Market Account. Roll Call taken: Thompson – YES, Weale – YES, Lyons – YES, and Becker – YES. Motion Adopted 4-0.
