DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS:

a. Assessor – August 10 is deadline for address changes.

b. Hwy Superintendent – Mowed shoulders, graded far end of John Rial Road, Mose Hill and started on Irish Hill Road which needs roughly 300 tons gravel on top. Mowed around shop, put new blades on mower, put a crossover pipe on Irish Hill, old one was broken in the center. Put a pipe in on Stapleton Road to add on to existing pipe. Cleaned ditch on Hibbard Road. Fuel log submitted, used 332.3 gallons of diesel fuel.

c. Town Clerk, Fire/Ambulance, Justice, DCO and Bookkeepers reports were read as submitted. Town Clerk noted that there are currently 52 expired dog licenses and DCO responded to 4 calls and impounded 1 dog. Received report from the Ambulance Corps, they made 17 runs and pumped 71.1 gallons of fuel from the village. Bookkeeper reported the following collections: Justice - \$790.00, Town Clerk – \$332.00, \$33,724.92 from sales tax, and \$2,773.17 in interest over all accounts. Recommended budget transfers:
